1. Summarize your accomplishments in Girl Scouting in recent years (e.g. Bronze, Silver, Gold Awards; significant badges, journeys, or religious scouting awards earned; Girl Scout leadership experiences; participation in product sales; camp experiences; etc.).
2. List extra-curricular and community service activities you have participated in during high school, the number of years, and your role. If you had a leadership role, note any challenging or rewarding aspects of the role.
3. What are your educational and career goals? Where do you see yourself in 5 years, post graduation?
4. State why you believe you should be considered for this scholarship. Include how Girl Scouting has helped you and how you apply the Girl Scout Promise and Law into your daily life. How will you demonstrate the Girl Scout principles while in college?
5. Explain your Gold Award project. Include the reason you selected your topic and what it means to you.
6. What was the impact of your project? Who did you reach and how did they benefit?
7. How were you personally affected by completing your project? What did you learn? What did you gain?

An official high school transcript, including ACT/SAT test results, is required. Letters of reference must be in separately sealed and signed envelopes. They may be included or sent separately to Girl Scouts of Kansas Heartland, c/o Scholarship Committee, 360 Lexington Road, Wichita, KS 67218.

NOTE: You may be required to provide your social security number before receiving scholarship funds in order for the sponsoring organizations to meet various governmental reporting requirements.
