



Are You a Troop Product Manager?



There are necessary trainings that are mandatory for a volunteer to hold the role of Troop Product Manager. If you are a new Troop Product Manager, you must complete/attend the following:

- GSKH Product Program Manager Learning Path (gsLearn)
- Cookie Program Basic Training (in-person only)

If you are a returning Troop Product Manager and previously completed Funding the Fun and Troop Safety in gsLearn, you do not need to take trainings again. You only need to complete the administrative duties mentioned below to participate. We do strongly encourage you check out the GSKH Product Program Manager Learning Path in gsLearn. Your previously completed trainings in gsLearn will be recognized and marked in the learning path accordingly. And refreshers are always a good thing.

All new Troop Product Managers must attend Cookie Program Basic Training. This mandatory in-person only training is available from 12:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. at that particular Girl Scout Office location.

- Saturday, December 6, 2025: Wichita, KS
- Sunday, December 7, 2025: Hays, KS
- Saturday, December 13, 2025: Wichita, KS

Important: You must complete the above mentioned on-line training: GSKH Product Program Manager Learning Path in gsLearn, prior to attending the in-person Cookie Program Basic Training.

MyCookies, Inc.



The *MyCookies, Inc.* (for Girl Scouts and families) publication will begin arriving in homes on December 15. Everything Girl Scouts and families need to know about running their cookie business will be inside. A detachable Direct Order Card is included in this guide. Participants can start taking pre-orders as soon as it arrives in their mailbox. Also on December 15, all Girl Scouts will receive their launch email to begin their online store front in Digital Cookie. All Girl Scouts who are registered in our membership system by December 1, 2025, and are not carrying an unpaid balance from a previous participation, should receive *MyCookies, Inc.* and the Digital Cookie launch email.

As part of the Five Life Skills, troops will determine financial needs for the Girl Scout year and set their Troop Goal for the 2026 cookie season accordingly.

Important Dates:

- Pre-orders can begin: Dec. 15
- Troop Starting Initial Order: Jan. 18
- Cookie Booth Lottery Opens: Jan. 9
- Cookie Booth Lottery Runs: Jan. 17
- Cookie Delivery: Feb. 4 - 12 (remember we have 80 counties to cover and cannot be in all of them at the same time!)
- Cookie Booths and Pop-Up Stands Open: Feb. 13
- Cookie Program Ends: March 22
