Highest Awards



Put earning the highest awards in Girl Scouts on your to-do list for 2025! The Girl Scout Gold Award, Silver Award, and Bronze Award prove you've got what it takes to build a better today - and tomorrow. You embrace possibility when you're making the world a better place and dream of a better tomorrow. All three awards give you the chance to do big things while working on an issue you care about.

Thinking ahead...

If you are a Junior Girl Scout, consider the **Bronze Award**. Must be completed by Oct. 1 going into 6th grade. Suggested minimum hours 20.

If you are a Cadette Girl Scout, consider the **Silver Award**. Must be completed by

Oct. 1 going into 9th grade. Suggested minimum hours 50.

If you are a Senior or Ambassador Girl Scout, consider the **Gold Award**. Must be completed by Oct. 1 after your Senior year of high school. Suggested minimum hours 80.

Once you've completed your project, you'll have put in some serious work and have made a bold, sustainable impact on the world.
