- Take financial responsibility for all Girl Scout product picked up for my daughter. *I understand that Girl Scout product cannot be returned to the Troop or the Council.*
- Count Girl Scout product and/or money with the Troop Product Manager and *receive and save a receipt each time* I pick up product or turn in money. If I do not count the product and/or money and sign a receipt, I will be responsible for any discrepancies in product and/or money reported by the Troop Product Manager.
- I will be responsible for the Girl Scout product and/or money lost, damaged or stolen while in my possession. A filed Police Report or insurance claim will be required to be relieved of any financial responsibility due to loss, damage or theft.
- Be responsible for turning in all money by program deadlines to the Troop Product Manager or the Council.
- I understand that failure to turn in all monies owed may result in collection/legal action and program credits, program recognitions and Elite Entrepreneur Experience invitations will be withheld.

- Not sell Girl Scout product to third party re-sellers, i.e. Amazon retailers, store front businesses. Any resale or redistribution is prohibited as per GSUSA and vendor rules. Girl Scout product packaging clearly states that resale is prohibited.
- Not sell Girl Scout product in any commercial or family owned settings without my Girl Scout present. My Girl Scout may not sell Girl Scout product at liquor stores, bars, gun shows, casinos, smoke shops or other locations deemed inappropriate by GSUSA and Girl Scouts of Kansas Heartland.
- If a caregiver utilizes a personal credit card reader; i.e. a Square, Venmo, CashApp, etc, all credit card or bank transaction fees are the responsibility of the owner of the device/account.
- I understand that if recognition choices are not made by the program end date then the items chosen as DEFAULT will be selected on my Girl Scout's behalf. All recognition/event choices will be final on each program end date.

I understand that the monies collected for the 2023-2024 Girl Scouts of Kansas Heartland Product Programs are due to the Troop Product Manager/Council Product Program Staff by the following dates:

- Fall Program: November 11, 2023
- Cookie Program: March 18, 2024

If the Girl Scout Product Program monies are not turned into the Troop Product Manager/Council Product Program Staff, I understand that I will be turned over to the Girl Scouts of Kansas Heartland as a caregiver/adult with an unpaid balance.

As the caregiver/adult with an unpaid balance, I will receive a letter with the amount of the unpaid balance and a payment date of three weeks from the date of the letter. If the amount due is not paid within the three week period, I understand that I may be sent to a collection agency. If my debt is submitted to a collection agency, I will no longer have contact with Girl Scouts of Kansas Heartland regarding the matter of the unpaid balance and will have direct communication with the collection agency.

I understand that once the unpaid balance amount is sent to the collection agency, my Girl Scout, as well as other Girl Scouts physically residing in the same household, will not receive product program credits, product program recognitions, and any Elite Entrepreneur Experience Invitations and her Girl Scout troop and service unit will not be paid the proceeds from her sales.

I understand that I must pay the amount due plus additional collection agency fees before the next product program for my Girl Scout to be able to participate in any further Girl Scouts of Kansas Heartland product programs. This does not restrict my Girl Scout from participating in all other Girl Scout activities, i.e. troop, summer camp, registering for Girl Scouts, etc.
