### What's Coming Up

- Weekly meet with Girl Scouts/caregivers to:

  - Gather Funds
  - Write Deposits and go to the bank
- March 4: FINAL Planned Order opens at 5 p.m. CT for available Cupboards
- March 5 - 7: Planned Order #4 pickups
- March 6: 1<sup>st</sup> ACH Debit is processed
- March 7: 300+ Drawing - ALL Troop to Girl transfers should be completed as of 11:59PM. All participants with 300+ pkgs on account are eligible for drawing.
- March 8: FINAL Planned Order due at 11:59 p.m. CT

### 1st ACH Debit

All Troop Cookie Managers should have received an email last evening, containing the information pertaining to the amounts due for the first ACH debit coming up this Friday, March 6. This deadline and the details of this process are discussed on the website under **Finances in the For Cookie Volunteers** section, as well as mentioned on the **2026 Cookie Action Calendar**.

REMEMBER: Your Troop Balance Summary could be different with regards to the amount of online payments applied. The receiving of these payments is in

constant motion and the amounts could be different from the time this information was gathered for the email you received. Each troop is given credit for all online transactions at the time the information is pulled. These are applied against the total amount due prior to the 50% division being made.

Not unlike what you do at the troop level, the Council is now at the stage of shuffling product all over the state to meet the demands of Planned Orders. Walk-ins and add-ons to your Planned Order are not guaranteed. Each week we steadily move closer and closer to exchanges. And always for the top three sellers; Thin Mints, Caramel deLites and Peanut Butter Patties. We look to balance this demand between all varieties, with the ultimate goal of **zero cookies on hand at the end**. This is why there are times throughout the season that some varieties become scarcer than others.

Due to the structure and volume that is required for product ordering from the bakery, it is important to mention that the Council will not be ordering any further product. There is always product available some where; either within a troop or with your girls. Do not be afraid to move product between your girls to meet everyone's needs.
