- 3. Provide **two** reference letters from non-family members. The reference letters must be emailed by the person writing the reference letter to kwagner@gskh.org or placed in a sealed envelope with the writer's signature on the flap and submitted as a part of the full application packet.
- 4. Submit a copy of your official transcript, including grades, grade point average and ACT/SAT test results from your high school as a part of the full application packet. If your school will only send the transcript directly to GSKH, you are responsible for letting them know that the deadline is **January 15**.
- 5. All items are to be submitted by email or delivered to the address below by January 15.

Scholarship awards will be based upon the following criteria:

- Girl Scout Participation, including awards earned (Scoring 20%)
- Leadership in Girl Scouts and the community (Scoring 10%)
- Community Service (Scoring 10%)
- Education/Scholastic Achievement (Scoring 10%)
- Future Goals & Aspirations matching skill set and academic experience (Scoring 10%)
- Financial need (Scoring 20%)
- References (Scoring 10%)
- Application Presentation (Scoring 10%)

One of our focus areas for this scholarship is to increase participation and support girls with financial need and in under-represented groups.

Girls who meet these criteria will be eligible for interviews by the committee to be scheduled beginning in February. Interviews will be available virtually, depending on the girl's schedule.
