Community Service Reminder

Girl Scouts cannot, in their capacity as Girl Scouts, raise funds for another organization. In order words, the Girl Scout brand cannot be used to raise funds for anything other than Girl Scouts. It's a fine line between community service and fundraising but when money benefits the other organization it's a violation of our 501c3. Examples include: volunteering at a fundraising event (meal, craft show, 5k race); bell ringer for Salvation Army. Organizations see Girl Scouts as a source of free labor, so we get a lot of requests for 'service' that are not really in the best interest of Girl Scouts. Always evaluate if there is a fundraising violation. But also go a step further to evaluate if the request adds VALUE to our Girl Scout experience... Reading or playing games with the elderly - YES. Bussing tables at an event - NO. Don't be afraid to say no to these requests when they don't align with Girl Scout's mission or provide value to our members. And, as always, if you are unsure, reach out to your Troop Engagement staff. Also, remember that the Money Earning Project Application must be filled out if you plan to do any type of fundraiser BEFORE the fundraiser begins.

2025 National Advisory Board

GSUSA has 11 seats available on the national Girl Scout Advisory Board. Members of this board serve a 2-year term and contribute to key projects with staff at GSUSA.

Current Girl Scouts interested in taking on a leadership role and are in grades 6th- 10th may apply. Applications are due to GSKH by January 15th. We will select up to 2 nominees to submit to GSUSA. GSUSA will select members and notify them in early April 2025.

Those selected will have a role at the 2026 convention with travel expenses covered by GSUSA. Only girls who are not already National Delegates can apply.

College Scholarships Available

Girl Scouts of Kansas Heartland has a scholarship offering for Girl Scouts who have completed the Girl Scout Gold Award and will graduate in May 2025.

Also, there is a Sandy Remsberg Education Scholarship that is awarded to up to three graduating Girl Scouts.

Application deadline for these is January 21, 2025.
