

GSKH Training at a Glance

The following are basic training expectations for volunteer roles within all Girl Scouts of Kansas Heartland troops. These trainings will allow troop leaders and/or troop support volunteers to gain the tools needed to provide girls with a quality Girl Scout Leadership Experience. Product Sales and Service Unit volunteers will also find trainings beneficial to their roles.
